

# BREAKING A JOURNEY - Scenario 1

Country of Origin → KLIA → BREAKS JOURNEY → KLIA → Johor (JHB) (Senai Airport)

1. During check in (at country of origin) Competitor informs Airline:- a. Check out (destination) is KLIA not JHB. b. To declare firearms and ammunitions.
2. Airline personnel (at check in) will inform / alert Airport Security.
3. Airport Security will inspect the firearms & ammo and the relevant documentation (varies between airports).
4. Airport Security will escort the firearms & ammo and place them in the hold of the aircraft (as checked in baggage). No firearms or ammo is allowed in cabin.
5. Airport Security will communicate / inform KLIA Airport Security that the aircraft heading to KLIA is carrying firearms & ammo.
6. Competitor & Firearms & Ammo travel on the same aircraft to KLIA.
7. Upon arrival at KLIA:- a. Competitor goes through immigration & custom check points, checked out and collect baggage. b. At the same time, KLIA Airport Security goes to the aircraft, collect the firearms & ammo and bring them to the KLIA Airport Security office.
8. After Breaking the Journey, at KLIA Airport (to continue the journey to JHB for the Competitor):- a. The Competitor MUST go to the KLIA Airport Security office to retrieve / claim the stored firearms & ammo. The Airport Security & Police will check the firearms & ammo to ensure that they're all intact and safe. Once everything checked, the firearms & ammo <u>stay with the Airport Security</u> . b. The Competitor then goes to the Domestic Check In counter for his / her flight to JHB while KLIA Airport Security escorted the firearms & ammo and place them in the hold of the Competitor's aircraft to JHB.
9. KLIA Airport Security will communicate / inform JHB Airport Security that the aircraft heading to JHB is carrying firearms & ammo.
10. Competitor & Firearms & Ammo travel on the same aircraft to JHB.
11. Upon arrival in JHB:- a. The Competitor goes straight to the baggage collection area to collect his baggage. He / She does not have to go through Immigration check point because he / she is travelling via Domestic flight. But he / she may be subjected to custom check. b. At the same time, JHB Airport Security goes to the aircraft, collect the firearms & ammo and bring them to the JHB Airport Security office.
12. After collecting baggage, Competitor MUST look for the JHB Airport Security office (he/she may ask any Security officer around the baggage collection area).
13. Competitor goes to the JHB Airport Security office and declare that he/she is the owner of the firearms & ammo.
14. JHB Airport Security, Police & Match Liaison Officer will inspect the firearms & ammo (together with the Competitor) at the Security office.
15. Once everything is cleared, the firearms & ammo will be surrendered to the Competitor.
16. The Match Liaison Officer will escort the Competitor (and the firearms & ammo) out of the JHB Airport.
17. The firearms & ammo will then be transported / escorted to the Match Range Armoury for safekeeping while the Competitor will go to the hotel.

## BREAKING A JOURNEY - Scenario 2

Johor (JHB) (Senai Airport) → KLIA → BREAKS JOURNEY → KLIA → Country of Origin

1. During check in (at JHB Airport) Competitor informs Airline:-
  - a. Check out (destination) is KLIA not Country of Origin.
  - b. To declare firearms and ammunitions.
2. Airline personnel (at check in) will inform / alert Airport Security.
3. Airport Security will inspect the firearms and the relevant documentation (varies between airports).
4. Airport Security will escort the firearms and place them in the hold of the aircraft (as checked in baggage). No firearms or ammo is allowed in cabin.
5. Airport Security will communicate / inform KLIA Airport Security that the aircraft heading to KLIA is carrying firearms & ammo.
6. Competitor & Firearms & Ammo travel on the same aircraft to KLIA.
7. Upon arrival in KLIA:-
  - a. The Competitor goes straight to the baggage collection area to collect his baggage. He / She does not have to go through Immigration check point because he / she is travelling via Domestic flight. But he / she may be subjected to custom check.
  - b. At the same time, KLIA Airport Security goes to the aircraft, collect the firearms & ammo and bring them to the KLIA Airport Security office.
8. After collecting baggage, Competitor MUST look for the KLIA Airport Security office (he/she may ask any Security officer around the baggage collection area).
9. Competitor goes to the KLIA Airport Security office and declare that he/she is the owner of the firearms & ammo.
10. KLIA Airport Security & Police will inspect the firearms,(together with the Competitor) at the KLIA Airport Security office.
11. Once everything is cleared, the Competitor MUST now inform the KLIA Airport Security that he / she is breaking the journey and not going straight to the Country of Origin.
12. KLIA Airport Security will then request that the firearms & ammo be kept (temporarily) at the KLIA airport armoury until such time when the Competitor is ready to continue his / her journey back to the Country of Origin.
13. The Competitor will then be asked to pay for the firearms & ammo storage. The storage & handling charges is about USD30 per item per day.
14. Once all firearms properly stored, the Competitor may leave KLIA Airport to where ever he / she had planned to go.
15. After Breaking the Journey, at KLIA Airport (to continue the journey back to Country of Origin):-
  - a. The Competitor MUST go to the KLIA Airport Security office to retrieve / claim the stored firearms. The Airport Security & Police will check the firearms & ammo to ensure that they're all intact and safe. Once everything checked, the firearms & ammo stay with the Airport Security.
  - b. The Competitor then goes to the International Check In counter for his / her flight back to Country of Origin and Immigration & Custom clearance; while KLIA Airport Security escorted the firearms and place them in the hold of the Competitor's aircraft to Country of Origin.
16. KLIA Airport Security will communicate / inform Country of Origin Airport Security that the aircraft heading to Country of Origin is carrying firearms.
17. Competitor & Firearms & Ammo travel on the same aircraft back to Country of Origin.
